**re Planning Application P/2008/0156**

I am writing in relation to revisions to the above planning application for Dickens Yard. The main objections I have to the scheme are as follows:

- It is an overwhelmingly residential development which will not attract the present residents of Ealing into the town centre.
- The height and mass of the buildings is grossly out of scale with Ealing's low-rise landscape.
- Too many flats are packed at high density on the site.
- Traffic is planned via the residential roads north of the site which will cause huge congestion as will the one entry and exit point on Longfield Road.
- The large increase in the residential population will put tremendous strain on our local services which are already operating at capacity.
- There are no new facilities for leisure/cultural activities which would benefit the residents of Ealing.

The revisions to the scheme do nothing to address these concerns.
